CONSENT ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO DETERMINE CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS

UPON CONSIDERATION of the parties' Joint Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records filed February 14, 2024, the Court, having reviewed the file and being otherwise fully advised in the premises does hereby **FIND AS FOLLOWS**:

A. The parties have disclosed personal information in the course of this dissolution of marriage action which contains personal financial data and other records, more particularly described as Wife's Financial Affidavit (DIN #12) and Consent Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage with Exhibit A: Marital Settlement Agreement. Disclosure of this information may cause substantial injury and abuse to the parties and is, therefore, confidential under Rule 2.420(c)(9) of the Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration and Rule 12.400(c) of the Florida Family Law Rules of Procedure.

B. The degree, duration and manner of the requested confidentiality of the court records are no broader than necessary to protect the interests set forth in Paragraph A above.

C. No less restrictive measures are available to protect the interests set forth in Paragraph A above.

The Court does therefore ORDER, ADJUDE and DECREE that:

1. The Clerk of the Circuit Court is hereby directed to seal the file and otherwise prevent the dissemination to the public of the information in the Wife's Financial Affidavit (DIN #12), Notice of Filing Identification and the Consent Final Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage with Exhibit A: Marital Settlement Agreement.

2. Except for those persons named in any subsequent order and under the conditions set forth in any such order, the following are the only persons to have access to and allowed inspection of this file:

- a. The parties Yvette Kapelka and Mark Kapelka.
- b. The parties' attorneys, Tawny Rountree and Amber Hines and their employees in fulfillment of their duties.
- c. The Clerk of the Circuit Court and employees thereof in fulfillment of their duties.
- d. Any person who establishes that disclosure of the information is necessary for government or judicial accountability or has a proper first amendment right to the information.

3. The parties and counsel are admonished that they are ordered, likewise, not to disclose or divulge any such information to any individual other than those set forth herein.

4. The Clerk of the Circuit Court is hereby directed to publish this order in accordance with Florida Rules of General Practice and Judicial Administration, Rule 2.420(d)(4).
