

OBTAINING A MARRIAGE LICENSE IN CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA






- The Clerk of Court does <u>not</u> conduct marriage ceremonies.
- Marriage licenses issued in Clay County are only valid for marriage ceremonies conducted in the state of Florida.
- An Appointment is required; scan this QR code to schedule or go to the Marriage License page at clayclerk.com:







- Application is <u>not complete until both parties appear in person</u> <u>at the Clerk's Office</u>, even if application is done online at clay-clerk.com; follow instructions on the website.
- Marriage License Application Fee = \$86 (less if premarital course completed; additional fees may apply)
- Premarital Statement Form is required for all couples and must be signed in front of the Clerk at our office.
- License valid 60 days after issuance; 3-day waiting period required for Florida residents unless premarital class completed and proof of class completion is provided prior to issuance.
- Marriage license must be certified and filed with Clerk's Office where issued within 10 days of the ceremony.
