**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DETERMINE
CONFIDENTIALITY OF COURT RECORDS**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on Defendants/Counterclaim Plaintiffs, Brandon Wittwer and Kassandra Wittwer's Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records under Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.420. The Court, having reviewed the Motion and the court file, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, finds that there is good cause to grant the relief requested and that Defendants' residential address is confidential under Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9), therefore, it is:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. Defendants' Motion to Determine Confidentiality of Court Records is GRANTED.
2. Defendants' residential address and any information that directly identifies the location of their home are determined confidential under Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.420(c)(9).

3. The Clerk of Court is directed to redact Defendants' residential address from all pages of the following docket items before making those documents available for public access or remote electronic access:

Docket Items: 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 12, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 25, and 31.

4. The Clerk of Court is further directed to redact Defendants' residential address from any document filed in this case in the future before making such document available for public access or remote electronic access.

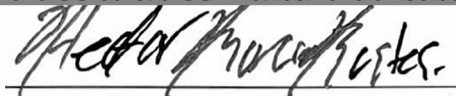
5. The Clerk of Court shall maintain the unredacted versions of any affected documents as confidential and shall permit access only to the Court, the Clerk of Court and authorized Clerk personnel, the parties, counsel of record, court personnel, and any other person authorized by further order of this Court.

6. The parties shall avoid including Defendants' residential address in future filings unless necessary.

7. The Clerk of Court is directed to publish this Order as required by Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.420(e)(4), without disclosing confidential information.
